PAULINA STOCHNIAŁEK

Born in Poznań, a graduate of the WSB University in Finance and Accounting and the Adam Mickiewicz University in Marketing and Management, with an MBA degree.

In 2018, she was elected by voters from the list of the Civic Coalition to become a Councilor of the Wielkopolska Region for 2018-2023. Since July 13, 2020, she has been a Member of the Management Board of the Wielkopolska Region and supervised the following departments: Health, Education and Science and the Regional Center for Social Policy in Poznań.

She has always been active in the Wielkopolska Region. She is a politician, coach, an entrepreneur with 25 years of professional experience in the public and private sectors. In her career so far, she has been the finance and HR director in an international corporation, the chief accountant of the largest clinical hospital in the Wielkopolska Region, a university lecturer, the president of an IT company in recent years.

She actively supports women in their personal and professional development. People are at the center of her interests, and she sees the local government as service to the inhabitants of the region. She believes that local government policy means responsibility for creating pro-social attitudes and activities for local communities. She is involved in the promotion of civic education, including young people in decision-making about their region.

She is a social economy promoter. An ambassador of the local government brand "Klunkry". An open society is her priority, which is why in social policy she emphasizes the inclusion of excluded people and their families in life activities, focusing on wise aid. She boldly creates space for pro-women's activities, such as the implementation of the "Career Cycle" Kulczyk Foundation program at the Marshal Office.

According to her, efficient management in provincial medical facilities is currently a particularly difficult challenge. Overseeing the Department of Health, she coordinates the local government IVF program for the region. As a member of the "Yes to in vitro" committee, she actively works to subsidize treatments from the state budget.

Privately, a wife, mother of two children, a fan of football, cycling routes along the Wielkopolska Region trails and travel.



JACEK BOGUSŁAWSKI

Born in Piła, graduate of Stanisław Staszic secondary technical school in Piła, popularly called "Nafta", and the University of Szczecin where he majored in economics. From 2010, he was a Member of the Piła



City Council for two terms of office, and a chairman of the municipal economy community. For nearly 23 years, he conducted an economic activity as an owner of CREDO Promotion and Commerce Studio dealing with the publication of training materials relating to driving learning and road safety intended for both children and adults. Products and services offered by CREDO are popular country-wide, and young drivers who have used materials published by the Piła-based company for the last dozen or so years to pass the driving test can now be counted in millions. While carrying out the business, he was also a member of the Business Centre Club and Chamber of Commerce of the Northern Wielkopolska Region. Since November 2018, Jacek Bogusławski is a member of the Board of the Wielkopolska Region.

Jacek Bogusławski began his professional career in the no longer existing Rail Rolling Stock Repair Workshops in Piła. Then he worked in the Szczecin branch of Polish Television and "Puls" Marketing Office in Koszalin, later to become director of its Piła branch. He is the founder and co-founder of initiatives that have influenced the life of the local North Wielkopolska community. By founding, together with Mariusz Szalbierz, a well-known journalist from Piła, FaktyPilskie.pl website and newspaper as well as the "Strefa Jazdy" magazine dedicated to driving, Jacek Bogusławski proved that it is possible to create in Piła something from scratch that can successfully compete with the existing media. For many years, he has been actively supporting children, young people and seniors in the region. He has been actively promoting sport among young people as a co-founder of a futsal club in Piła and its titular sponsor; The team – in spite of initial scepticism – has begun to achieve spectacular successes, surprising disbelievers.

Jacek Bogusławski has initiated many football and chess tournaments in Piła and the micro-region – all of them have been regularly held for years. Cooperating with the Regional Traffic Center, the police, sports clubs and schools, Jacek Bogusławski supports, often also financially, a number of social initiatives aimed at promoting desirable attitudes, sport, culture and safety of children, as well as their intellectual development.

In his free time, he likes playing tennis, jogging and swimming.
